2. Focuses on more than one of the above groups, or focuses on one group, provided that the course compares and contrasts the experiences of that group with another group.

3. Includes analysis of ethnicity, ethnocentrism, and racism and how these concepts explain and shape ethnic experiences in the United States.

4. Includes an examination of such factors as race, class, gender, age, sexual preference, and how these shape ethnic experiences in the United States.

5. Explores the role culture plays in shaping and sustaining ethnic groups.
