General Education–Breadth Requirements

The CSU General Education–Breadth Requirements may change each year. It is the student’s responsibility to check with a counselor each year for updated CSU General Education–Breadth Requirements.

To complete these requirements, students must have a 2.0 (2.4 for international and non-resident) or higher grade point average (GPA) for all courses taken to complete the General Education–Breadth Requirements.

To transfer, students must meet the following requirements:

1. 60 transferable units including a minimum of 30 units from the General Education Breadth- Requirements.
2. Completion of **Area A, sections 1, 2 and 3 and Area B, section 4 with a grade of “C” or better,**
3. **2.0 grade point average** for all transferable course work completed.

** Courses are listed in more than one section in that area or other areas but can only be used once to satisfy a requirement.

California State University, Sacramento (CSUS)

1. **Race and Ethnicity Requirement** (CSUS graduation requirement): As of August 21, 1998, CSUS requires 3 units to meet their Race and Ethnicity requirement. The following SCC courses have been approved to meet this requirement. **COMM 325(SP2006), ENGLT 334 (SP2002), SOCSOC 300 (SU2005), SOC 321 (SU2005).**
2. **FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT** (CSUS graduation requirement): Effective Summer 2004, the foreign language requirement can be met by one of the following:
 - a. Completion of two semesters (402 level at SCC) of a foreign language at a community college or university or DEAF 312 **or**
 - b. Completion of three years of the same language with a “C” grade or better in high school **or**
 - c. Completion of a minimum of two years foreign language in high school with a “C” grade **or** better and completion of one semester of a foreign language (402 or higher or DEAF 312 level) at a community college or university with a “C” grade or better **or**
 - d. Advanced Placement Foreign Language Examination scores of 3.4 or 5 **or**
 - e. Graduation from a high school (secondary school) where the language of instruction was not English **or**
 - f. See a counselor for other options.

The following majors (BS degree) are exempt from the foreign language requirement for graduation (Fall 2013). Business Administration, Chemistry/Biochemistry(BS), Computer Science, Engineering, Health Science, Kinesiology- Athletic Training concentration, Nursing, Physics, Recreation, Parks and Tourism Administration.

3. **ENGLISH COMPOSITION** (CSUS graduation requirement): For students whose catalog is Fall 1992 or later, an additional English composition course is required for graduation. SCC ENGWR 301 or 302 will be accepted to meet this requirement. Either one of these courses may also be double-counted in area A-3 and C-2 (prior to Fall 2006). ENGWR 303 (F14) also satisfies this requirement.
4. CSU, Sacramento requires a total of 51 units of general education for graduation. Students may choose to take additional units from AREA B at SCC. The remaining 9 units of general education must be upper division and taken at the university level.
